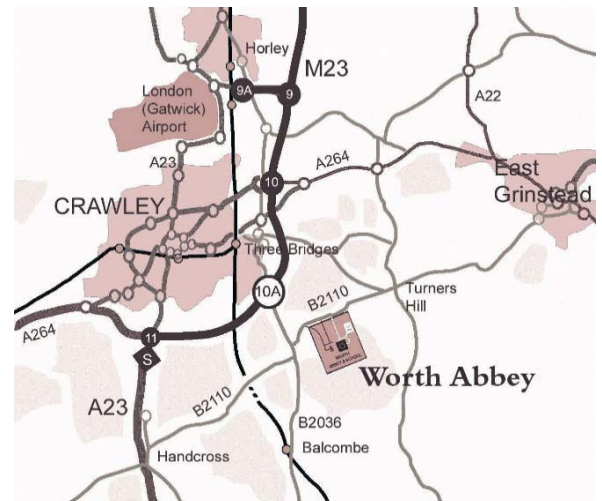
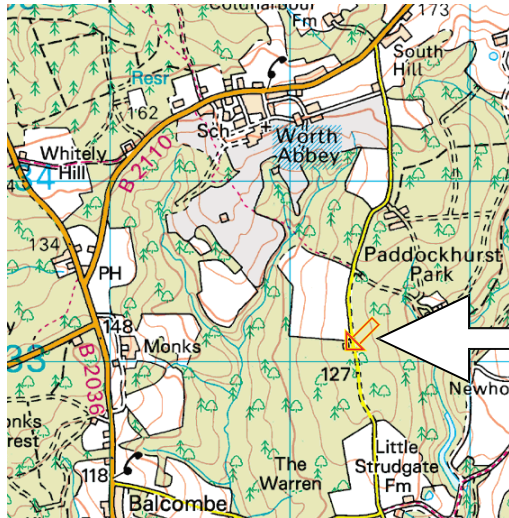


Where are Worth Abbey and the Bermondsey Huts?

By Rail: Three Bridges Station (on the London to Brighton line) is 4 miles away. We advise taking a taxi as there is no direct bus route.

By Road: Bermondsey Huts are one mile down a road named 'Back Lane' (off Paddockhurst Road), which forms the Eastern Boundary of the Worth Abbey estate. The Huts are about where the 'W' of 'Worth Abbey' is on the map (right).

2. At the top, tap the search box and type the plus code.
